



Silent Auction Rules

Each Silent Auction item has a unique number on the item and on the corresponding bid sheet.

Bidding starts at \$20 with increments of \$5 minimum.

Reserve bids will be accepted. See a Silent Auction Volunteer for a form. The winning bid will be whichever is higher - the final 'sheet' bid or the reserve bid.

Bids must be written in ink – no pencils.

Enter your bid, your name, and your phone number on the 1st available line of the bid sheet.

No bid can be less than previous bids.

Changes to a bid can only be made by the bidder and must be initialled by the bidder.

Close of Bidding is 3 p.m. Sunday November 9th, 2008.

No bids accepted after that time.

Successful bidders are responsible for paying for all auction items via **cash or cheque only**.

Items may be paid for and picked up between 3:30 p.m. and 6 p.m. Sunday November 9th, 2008.

Bidders not present will be called between 3 and 6 p.m. on November 9th. If not available, arrangements will be made for later payment and pickup of the item(s).
