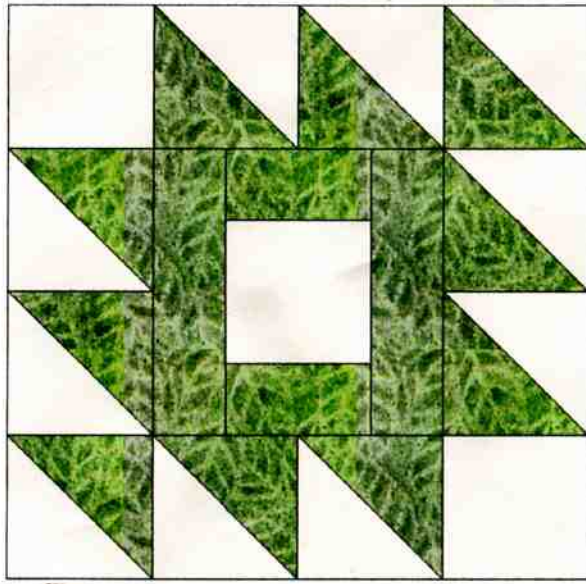




Block of the Month It's a Puzzle

Rocky Mountain Puzzle

This block was first published as a Nancy Cabot pattern in 1933.



Due: November 23, 2004

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Fabrics: 100% cotton

Colours: 1=medium or dark batik or traditional fabric that reminds you of mountains
2= tone on tone white or cream background fabric

Method: Cut and mark using templates A,B,C and D on the back of this page.

OR

Rotary cut from fabric 1 five 3 7/8" squares
two 2" x 3 1/2" rectangles
two 2" x 6 1/2" rectangles
2 five 3 7/8" squares
three 3 1/2" squares

Place 3 7/8" squares of fabric 1 and fabric 2 right sides together. Mark the diagonal on the background fabric and sew 1/4" on either side of the marked line. Cut on the marked line and press to the dark side. Trim the resulting half square triangle squares to 3 1/2" with a square ruler. Make a total of ten 3 1/2" squares. Add rectangles of fabric 1 to one of the 3 1/2" squares of fabric 2. Assemble according to the diagram. The finished block should measure 12 1/2".
